Job Description

TSC is looking for a qualified part-time seasonal facilitator to join our team. TSC offers experiential STEM programs for children and adults in person and virtually. Seasonal facilitators primarily provide program support for field trips, day camps, and summer camps during spring, summer, and/or fall program seasons. Reports to Director of Programs.

Responsibilities

- Facilitate programming: field trips, day camps, summer camps, and occasionally other programs
- Organize, collect, prepare, and manage materials for programming
- Participate in wildlife and habitat conservation, sustainability practices, and water quality analysis
- Assist with garden and farm maintenance in preparation for, for use during, and at the conclusion of program seasons
- Duties as assigned

- Associate's or Bachelor's Degree in education or a STEM-related field preferred
- Experience working with children
- Ability to complete tasks in a professional, effective, and efficient manner
- Strong oral and written communication skills
- Ability to work as part of a team and independently
- Coachable and a lifelong learner

- Ability to work flexible hours (hours vary by season)
